## 摘要

Aims and methods: To survey the spatial uses by shophouse occupants in preserve-based of living courtyards. There has been litter work in Taiwan on the private's intention of the inner courtyard preservation and the treatments they use. Using a questionnaire as pilot test, we compared a sample (up to this paper) representing the general population (n=83) with a sample attending enclosed courtyards (n=34) to access their level of preservation.

Results: Nearly half of the general population sample had closed or covered the original living courtyards and become as part of shop section. The major reasons are a need of space enlargement and due to water protection. It would seem therefore that become a trend in Taiwan.

Implication: If the general public do not care about the natural value of courtyards, this is likely to limit the public interest to the street frontages only.
