地方政府治理指標建構之初探

摘要

The study examines evaluation indices of local governments made by Common Wealth and Vision since 2003. The study found out the following weakness from previous magazines: 1. Unanimous indices are unable to reflect the policy priorities of individual local government. 2. Indices without variance cannot measure policy performances appropriately. 3. Some contents of indices evaluate public affairs beyond local government authorities. 4. There are no obvious causal relationships between contents of indices and actions of local government. 5. The selection of survey questions on local government approval rating shows arbitrary. The study suggest governance indices of local government should adopt customized and dynamic evaluation system. In addition, governance indices of local government need to meet the following requirements: 1. Evaluation indices need to reflect the policy priorities of local governments. 2. Policy priorities of local governments should echo visions of local governments. 3. Visions of local governments have to mirror needs of local citizens. 4. Outcomes of performance indices should meet the extent of satisfaction of local citizens.
