Abstract

This study investigates the six economic policies currently that relate to the development of logistics have been included in the macroeconomic construction policies of the ROC government such as “i-Taiwan12 Projects” and “Direct Cross-strait flights and marine transport”. The latter has attracted the concern and attention from the international communities because it will bring more commercial trades between both sides of strait and promotes the Taiwan's logistical industry to develop in the mainland. Due to the implementation of economic constructions, the demand of logistical talent has continuously increased. This means that the large quantity of human resource input is required.
