

國中生網路經驗與人際互動對網路成癮傾向行為之影響

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摘要

With the rapid development of the Internet, people prefer to have fun and talk to the others online. The Internet addiction behaviors of junior high school students have become a serious problem. To understand the Internet addiction behaviors, this study inquires the personal and family related factors among junior high school students. A survey is conducted by sampling on 277 students in a junior high school in Taichung. The data is collected in interpersonal interactions, the values of online games and Internet addiction behaviors. The data is analyzed by descriptive statistics and ANOVA. The following results are obtained: (1) the male junior high students have more symptoms of internet addiction behaviors than females, (2) the parents who overlook about their children's online behaviors let the junior high students have internet addiction behaviors, (3) the junior high students who are online over eight hours per week have more internet addiction behaviors than the others, (4) the junior high students who have good relationship with keypals have more internet addiction behaviors than the others, (5) the fun of online games let the junior high students forget the school homework and life problems.
